The 2005 D'Adamo wine is opaque ruby-purple with notes of ripe raspberry syrup, black cherry and cassis. There are layers of mocha, toasty brioche and vanilla cream on the palate. The wine coats the entire mouth and has big, but well-integrated tannins. Drink now or over the next 10 years.
