The 2005 Firehouse is a ruby color. The nose has aromas of stewed cassis, briary fruits, sage and savory herbs. The mouth reveals flavors of cherry, cassis and raspberry. The finish is balanced with fruit and toasty oak. Drink now or over the next 5 years.
