2005 New Releases

Happy Holidays!! We can't think of a better way to celebrate the holidays than with the release of not one, but two of our signature vineyard designate wines. We hope you enjoy them as much as we do.

2005 Yountville "Wolff" Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

This is the inaugural release from this sustainably farmed vineyard in the heart of the Yountville Appellation. This wine is deep ruby in color and full of old world flavors. It has hints of blackberry, rhubarb pie and toasty oak followed by earthy notes. A good mouth feel provides the backbone for a long finish. \$72 per bottle (230 Cases were produced)

2005 Napa Valley "D'Adamo Vineyard" Cabernet Sauvignon

Located just off of Hardman Ave and the Silverado Trail, this vineyard creates a beautiful wine that screams classical California Cabernet. This wine is opaque ruby purple with notes of crème de cassis, raspberry syrup and black cherry. There are flavors of bittersweet cocoa and toasty wood spice on the palate. The wine coats the entire mouth and has big, but well-integrated tannins. \$72 per bottle (1100 Cases were produced)

2007 Harvest is Complete

At Piña Napa Valley, we began harvesting our vineyard designate Cabernets in mid-September with the Ames Vineyard in Oakville. We then had a small hiatus before we brought in the D'Adamo Vineyard from the Napa Valley, the Firehouse Vineyard in Rutherford and the Wolff Vineyard in Yountville during the first half of October. We finished the harvest at the end of October by picking the Buckeye Vineyard up on Howell Mountain.



Overall in Napa, the rain did not have much of an effect on Cabernet but winemakers had to check on their vineyards more often than usual to make sure that rot did not develop. The cooler weather and rain made it the "longest harvest ever" according to some winemakers in Napa. The 2007 wines are big and powerful yet they have balance and finesse. The Cabernets exhibit deep concentrated color, are well structured and the tannins are not drying or overbearing. Overall, the 2007 vintage produced some phenomenal wines.
