2009 Wines Update

We are racking the 2009 wines and have just made the Mimbres and Cahoots blends. These wines will continue to age in barrel for another year before bottling next spring. The wines of 2009 are showing great potential. They are wonderfully ripe and balanced with many layers and substance.

2009 Chardonnay

After many years of producing just single vineyard designate Cabernet Sauvignon we have decided to round out our lineup and add a single vineyard Chardonnay from the Oak Noll AVA. We are excited to share this amazing wine with you this summer. The 2009 Piña Low Vineyard Chardonnay is a pale straw color. The nose exhibits aromas of pear, apple, and ripe melon. The unctuous mouth feel is complimented by balanced acidity and followed by a hint of toasty oak.

In the Vineyards

The 2010 harvest is currently scheduled to come in a couple of weeks later than usual. The spring and early summer weather has been unseasonably cool relative to previous years in the Napa Valley. We also had late rains this year lasting throughout the month of May. It finally started to warm up at the end of June and we now have a forecast with temperatures hovering in the quintessential July range of high eighties to low nineties in the heart of the valley. This weather is definitely putting us back on track. All of our vineyards have gone through bloom and the crop load has been set. We are currently going through the vineyards to do canopy management. It is important to tuck shoots into the wires, pull lateralals and top the vines so that we have optimum indirect sun exposure and maximum air circulation around the clusters. The next major phenological stage will be veraison when the red wine grapes turn from green to red in color.
